Consequent to the DPC held on 30.12.2022 for the vacancy year 2023, the following Private Secretaries are hereby promoted on regular basis to the grade of Senior Private Secretary (Group-B Gazetted) in the Level:8 of the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC Pay Matrix (equal to PB-2 ₹9300-34800 with corresponding Grade pay of ₹ 4800/-) with effect from the date of assumption of charge of the post, not before 01.01.2023 and posted on in-situ basis until further orders.

02. The above officers should join on or after **01.01.2023** and the promotion will be effective from the date of joining as Senior Private Secretary. The promotion is subject to the condition that the officers join in the promoted cadre not later than **10.01.2023** failing which it will be treated that the officer has not accepted the promotion ab initio and all consequences arising as a result of non-acceptance of promotion shall follow.

03. The officer working on deputation basis, should be repatriated and she should assume charge as Senior Private Secretary in CCA-Estt section, Office of the Principal Chief Commissioner of GST & Central Excise, Chennai-34, failing which it will be treated as non-acceptance of promotion.

04. The seniority of the promoted officers will be fixed as per orders in force.

05. The promoted officer may exercise her option for fixation of pay under FR22(1)(a)(i) within one month from the date of receipt of this order. However, if the officer has already

been granted financial upgradation under Assured Career Progression Scheme/Modified Assured Career Progression prior to promotion she is not entitled for any fixation benefits.

06. The promotion now ordered is subject to outcome of the following:

(i) W.P.C.T.No.261/2008 filed by Samiran Roy and others before the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta in terms of Board's letter F.No.C-18012/6/2009.Ad.III.B dated 16.09.2010,

(ii) Further orders that may be passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the said batch of cases, since the Jarnail Singh batch of cases in SLC(C) No.30621 of 2011 is pending.

(iii) Any other pending cases, before any judicial fora.
